Association of the Century, Inc. Board of Directors' Meeting - February 9, 2021 Fourth Quarter Treasurer's Report 1 October through 31 December, 2020

For the calendar year 2020, total receipts exceeded total disbursements by \$2,685. Of significance for the year, was the increase of life memberships to \$2,060, interest income of \$2,846, and advertising revenues of \$4,800. In December, The Association paid \$2,900 in liability insurance and donated \$2,000 to the Scholarship Fund. In the fourth quarter, total disbursements exceeded total receipts by \$3,302. As of 31 December 2020, Total Net Assets are \$123,363.

As of 31 December 2020, The General's "Franklin Club Challenge" has raised \$20,032 from 130 participants; \$12,127 has been designated to the Scholarship Fund; \$2,139 to the SOS Fund, \$1,212 to the Museum Fund and \$4,550 has been designated unrestricted. See the attached list of the 130 individuals who have participated in the "Franklin Challenge".

- 2. Total investments are \$114,045 at the end of calendar year 2020. All Certificates of Deposit (CD) are held at Fort Knox Federal Credit Union; presently there are six (6) certificates. Interest income for the calendar year was \$2,846.
- 3. During the calendar year of 2020, the Support Our Soldiers (SOS) Program had \$50 in donations and no expenses. The balance of Temporarily Restricted Assets for the program at the end of 2020 and 2019 was \$5,583 and \$5,533, respectively.

The SOS Program started in 2003; as of 31 December 2019 total donations have been \$49,917 and expenditures have been \$44,334.

- 4. During the calendar year of 2020, the Museum Fund received no donations and made no expenditures. The balance of Temporarily Restricted Assets for the Museum at the end of 2020 remained at \$7,221.
- 5. The financial activities for the MG Benjamin J. Butler "Century Division" Scholarship Fund for the calendar year 2020 are outlined in the attached schedule. As of 31 December 2020, the fund balance is \$273,850.16. During the fourth quarter, in addition to the donations made directly to the Foundation for the Franklin Club, the Scholarship fund received \$200 from Elizabeth L. Grossi, \$100 from Ken Kapp, \$500 from Elmo Martin, \$500 from Richard Dale Miller, and \$2,000 from the Association of the Century.

For the year ended December 31, 2020, the Fund returned, net of fees, at the annual rate of 12.8%.

The MG Benjamin J. Butler "Century Division" Scholarship Fund was established by The Association of the Century in December 2017 at the Community Foundation of Louisville. The Foundation has received \$186,617.55 in donations and has paid out 83 grants of \$83,000.
