Association of the Century, Inc. Board of Directors' Meeting - November 9, 2022 Third Quarter Treasurer's Report 1 July through 30 September, 2022

Total disbursements have exceeded total receipts in the third quarter by \$1,669; and for the nine months ended disbursements have exceeded receipts by \$4,431. In the third quarter, all the significant transactions have been due to the activities of the Annual Meeting in Bowling Green on 26, 27 & 28 August 2022. The receipts and disbursements from the Forty-First Annual Meeting are detailed in the attached schedule. As of 30 September 2022, Total Net Assets are \$128,306.

As of 30 September 2022, The General's "Franklin Club Challenge" has raised \$29,982 from 145 participants; \$21,252 has been designated to the Scholarship Fund; \$2,214 to the SOS Fund; \$1,266 to the Museum Fund; and \$5,250 has been designated as unrestricted. See the attached list of the 145 individuals who have participated in the "Franklin Club Challenge."

- Total investments have increased to \$118,119 as of the end of the third quarter of 2022. All Certificates of Deposit (CD) are held at Abound Federal Credit Union, formally the Fort Knox Federal Credit Union. Presently there are six (6) certificates. Interest income for the second quarter of 2022 is \$545.
- 3. During the third quarter, the Support Our Soldiers (SOS) Program had no expenses and no donations. The balance of Temporarily Restricted Assets for the program at the end of the first quarter was \$5,658.

The SOS Program started in 2003; as of 30 September 2022 total donations were \$49,992 and expenditures were \$44,334.

- 4. During the third quarter, the Museum Fund had no expenses and no donations. The balance of Temporarily Restricted Assets for the Museum on 30 September 2022 was \$3,282.
- 5. The financial activities for the MG Benjamin J. Butler "Century Division" Scholarship Fund for the first, second and third quarters 2022 are outlined in the attached schedule. As of 30 September 2022, the fund balance is \$234,668.
