# Association of the Century, Inc. Board of Directors' Meeting Second Quarter Treasurer's Report August 6, 2024

- 1. Cash receipts exceeded cash disbursements for the second quarter and the year to date ended June 30, 2023, by \$10,192 and \$15,751, respectively. Of significance in the second quarter were the receipts of \$4,336 in registration fees for the annual meeting; \$2,000, \$5,000, and \$2,000 in annual meeting sponsorships from the James L. Yates Post No. 9, Atmos Energy Corporation, and William G. Barron of Owensboro, Kentucky, respectively; and \$1,200 from Karl Truman Law Office for Sentinel advertisements. Cash disbursements in the second quarter included \$2,500 for use of the facility at the annual meeting, \$1,200 for the 2024 annual website maintenance, and \$2,350 to the Scholarship Fund for the transfer of funds to the Endowment Fund. As of June 30, 2024, Total Net Assets were \$147,490.
- 2. The State of Kentucky requires the Association to electronically file quarterly state sales tax reports. Payments to the State are made by ACH bank transfer. The last filing was for the quarter ending June 30, 2024.
- 3. The General's "Franklin Club Challenge" as of August 4, 2024 has raised \$36,147 from 151 participants; \$26,992 has been designated to the Scholarship Fund, \$2,289 to the SOS Fund, \$1,316 to the Museum Fund and \$5,550 has been designated unrestricted. See the attached list of the 150 individuals who have participated in the "Franklin Challenge."
- 4. Total investments are \$123,454 at the end of the second quarter. All Certificates of Deposit (CD) are held at Abound Federal Credit Union; presently there are six (6) certificates. Interest income for the second quarter was \$866.
- 5. During the second quarter, the Support Our Soldiers (SOS) Program had no donations and no expenses. Beginning January 1, 2024, the quarterly balance of the restricted assets was increased at the annual investment return of 5.0% per annum. For the first two quarters of 2024, \$120.00 was added to the restricted assets as the investment return. The balance of Temporarily Restricted Assets for the program at the end of the second quarter was \$4,928.
  - The SOS Program was started in 2003; as of June 30, 2024 total donations were \$50,042, total expenditures were \$45,234, and total investment returns were \$120.00.
- 6. During the second quarter, the Museum Fund received no donations and expenses of \$297.00. Beginning January 1, 2024, the quarterly balance of the restricted assets was increased at the annual investment return of 5.0% per annum. For the first two quarters of 2024, \$84.00 was added to the restricted assets as the investment return. The balance of Temporarily Restricted Assets for the Museum on 30 June 2024 was \$3,144.00.

- 7. The financial activities for the MG Benjamin J. Butler "Century Division" Scholarship Fund for the first and second quarters of 2024 are outlined in the attached schedule. As of June 30, 2024, the fund balance is \$310,069.85. The "Funds Available for Grantmaking" are increased monthly by 1/12<sup>th</sup> of 5.0% of the trailing thirty-six month average of the Fund balance. The same Funds are decreased when funds are distributed for scholarships.
- 8. The Scholarship Fund at the Community Foundation of Louisville (CFOL) has always been invested in the Signature Fund Program of the CFOL. The performance of the Signature Fund has been included with this Report.


In the first quarter, donations were made of \$350.00 from the Franklin Club Challenge and \$100.00 from Ken Kapp.
