Association of the Century, Inc. Board of Directors' Meeting Second Quarter Treasurer's Report August 5, 2025

- 1. Cash receipts exceeded cash disbursements for the second quarter and the year to date ended June 30, 2025, by \$13,388.00 and \$13,538.00, respectively. Of significance in the second quarter were the number and amount of cash receipts: the pass through donations to the Scholarship Fund of \$10,000.00 from Tom Bohannon and \$5,000.00 from Atmos Energy Corporation; \$5,103 in registration fees for the annual meeting; \$2,000 and \$5,000 in annual meeting sponsorships from the James L. Yates Post No. 9 and Veterans of Foreign Wars of the US, Post No. 696, respectively; \$1,193 from merchandise sales; and \$1,200 from Abound Credit Union for *Sentinel* advertisements. The major cash disbursements in the second quarter included \$1,368.00 for the 2025 annual website maintenance, and \$15,000 to the Scholarship Fund for the transfer of funds to the Endowment Fund. As of June 30, 2025, Total Net Assets were \$151,173.00.
- 2. Total investments are \$128,593.00 at the end of the second quarter. The two (2) Certificates of Deposit (CD) are held at Abound Federal Credit Union. On July 7, 2025, the smaller Certificate matured and was renewed in the amount of \$26,976.76 for 10 months at 4.52%. Interest income for the second quarter was \$1,507.
- 3. During the second quarter, the Museum Fund received donations of \$525.00 and had no expenses. For the first two quarters of 2025, \$83.00 was added to the restricted assets as the internal investment return on the Museum Fund. The balance of the Temporarily Restricted Assets of the Museum Fund on June 30, 2025 was \$3,933.00
 - Beginning January 1, 2024, the quarterly balance of the Museum Fund was increased at the annual internal investment rate of 5.0% per annum. As of June 30, 2025, total investment returns were \$248.00.
- 4. During the second quarter, the Support Our Soldiers (SOS) Program Fund had donations of \$50.00 and no expenses. For the first two quarters of 2025, \$101.00 was added to the restricted assets as the internal investment return on the SOS Program Fund. The balance of the Temporarily Restricted Assets of the SOS Program Fund on June 30, 2025 was \$4,219.00.
 - Beginning January 1, 2024, the quarterly balance of the restricted assets was increased at the annual investment return of 5.0% per annum.
 - The SOS Program was started in 2003; as of June 30, 2025 total donations were \$50,092, total expenditures were \$46,219, and total investment returns were \$346.00.

- 5. The General's "Franklin Club Challenge" as of August 3, 2025 has raised \$41,847 from 156 participants; \$32,617 has been designated to the Scholarship Fund, \$2,339 to the SOS Fund, \$1,341 to the Museum Fund and \$5,550 has been designated unrestricted. See the attached list of the 156 individuals who have participated in the "Franklin Challenge."
- 6. The financial activities for the MG Benjamin J. Butler "Century Division" Scholarship Fund for the first and second quarters of 2025 are outlined in the attached schedule. As of June 30, 2025, the fund balance is \$359,784.58.
 - The "Funds Available for Grantmaking" are increased monthly by 1/12th of 5.0% of the trailing thirty-six month average of the Fund balance. The same Funds are decreased when funds are distributed for scholarships. As of June 30, 2025, the "Funds Available for Grantmaking" are \$7,812.41.
- 7. The State of Kentucky requires the Association to electronically file quarterly state sales tax reports. Payments to the State are made by ACH bank transfer. The last filing was for the quarter ending June 30, 2025.
- 8. The Kentucky application for the AOC's 2025 Temporary License Applications have been successfully submitted to the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. The State licensing specialist is Mandy Otis.
 - The City of Owensboro ABC Application has also been completed and submitted with a check of \$100.00 made to the Owensboro ABC. The City of Owensboro administrator is Dana Coomes.
